
2 Description

SNx4AHC138 decoders/demultiplexers designed for high-performance memory-decoding and data-routing applications that require very short propagation-delay times. In high-performance memory systems, these decoders can be used to minimize the effects of system decoding. When employed with high-speed memories utilizing a fast enable circuit, the delay times of these decoders and the enable time of the memory usually are less than the typical access time of the memory. This means that the effective system delay introduced by the decoders is negligible.




Figure 3-1. D, DB, DGV , N, NS , or PW Package, 16-Pin SOIC, SSOP, TVSOP, PDIP, SOP, or TSSOP (Top View)





Figure 3-2. RGY Package, 16-Pin VQFN (Top View)



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
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6 Detailed Description

6.1 Overview

The conditions at the binary-select inputs and the three enable inputs select one of eight output lines. Two active-low and one active-high enable inputs reduce the need for external gates or inverters when expanding. A 24-line decoder can be implemented without external inverters, and a 32-line decoder requires only one inverter. An enable input can be used as a data input for demultiplexing applications.




Figure 7-1. 24-Bit Decoding Scheme




Figure 7-2. 32-Bit Decoding Scheme

7.3 Layout

7.3.1 Layout Guidelines

When using multiple-input and multiple-channel logic devices, inputs must never be left floating. In many cases, functions or parts of functions of digital logic devices are unused; for example, when only two inputs of a triple-input AND gate are used or only 3 of the 4 buffer gates are used. Such unused input pins must not be left unconnected because the undefined voltages at the outside connections result in undefined operational states. All unused inputs of digital logic devices must be connected to a logic high or logic low voltage, as defined by the input voltage specifications, to prevent them from floating. The logic level that must be applied to any particular unused input depends on the function of the device. Generally, the inputs are tied to GND or V_{CC} , whichever makes more sense for the logic function or is more convenient.




Figure 7-3. Example Layout for the SN74AHC138
