- For the high damping special quality, the high effect is shown by a receiver sensitivity measure of an FM band by 66MHz to 108MHz and 108MHz to 400MHz.





## Z FREQUENCY CHARACTERISTICS




## INSERTION LOSS VS. FREQUENCY CHARACTERISTICS




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## Z, X, R vs. frequency characteristics








### REEL DIMENSIONS






## RECOMMENDED LAND PATTERN

### REMINDERS

- The storage period is within 12 months. Be sure to follow the storage conditions (temperature: 5 to 40°C, humidity: 10 to 75% RH or less).  
If the storage period elapses, the soldering of the terminal electrodes may deteriorate.
- Do not use or store in locations where there are conditions such as gas corrosion (salt, acid, alkali, etc.).
- Soldering corrections after mounting should be within the range of the conditions determined in the specifications.  
If overheated, a short circuit, performance deterioration, or lifespan shortening may occur.
- When embedding a printed circuit board where a chip is mounted to a set, be sure that residual stress is not given to the chip due to the overall distortion of the printed circuit board and partial distortion such as at screw tightening portions.
