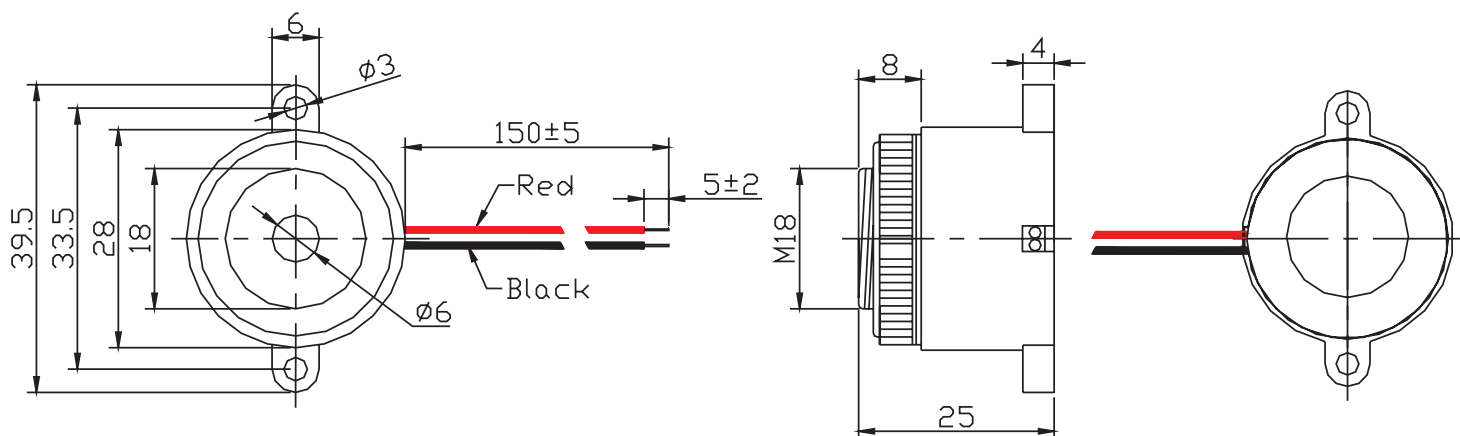

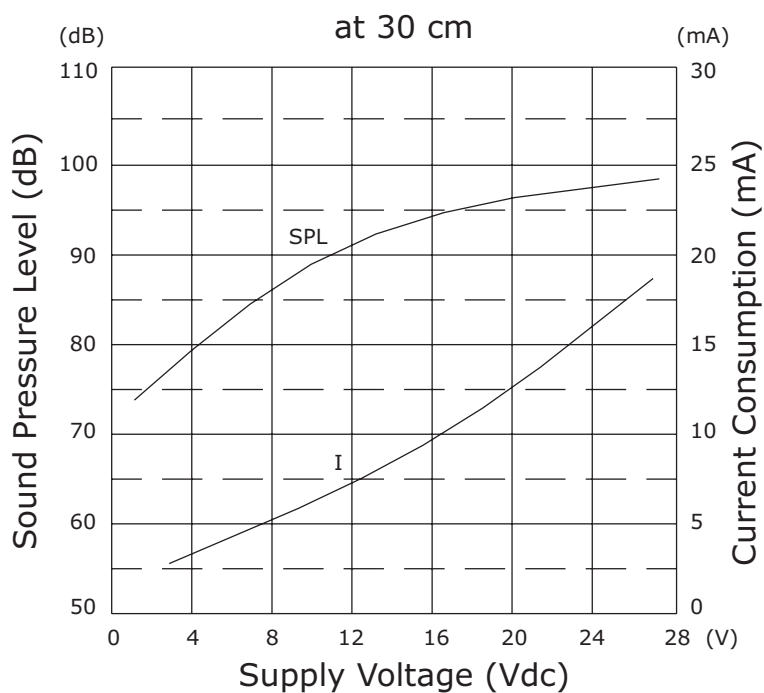

SPL: Voltage vs. Sound Pressure Level

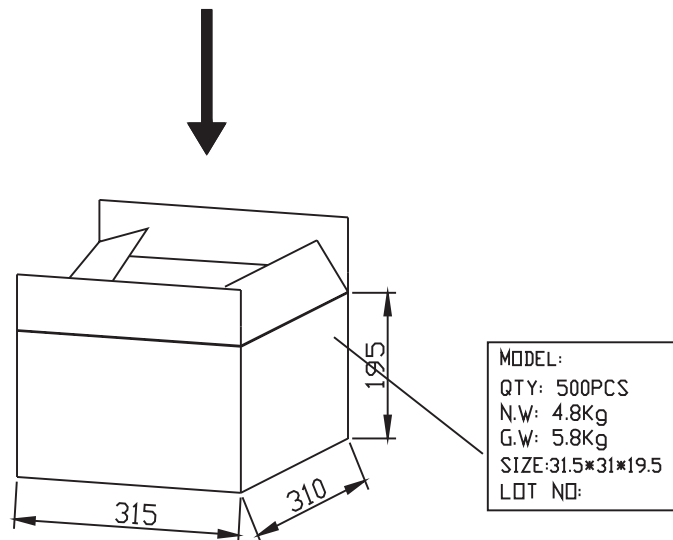
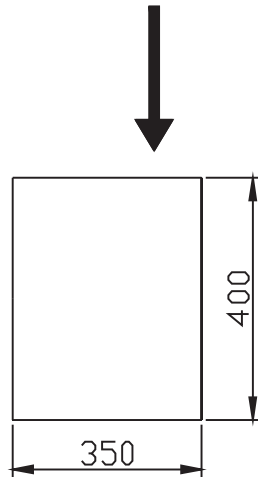
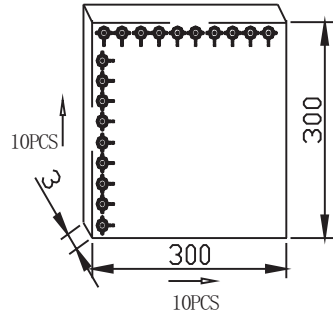
I: Voltage vs. Current Consumption
