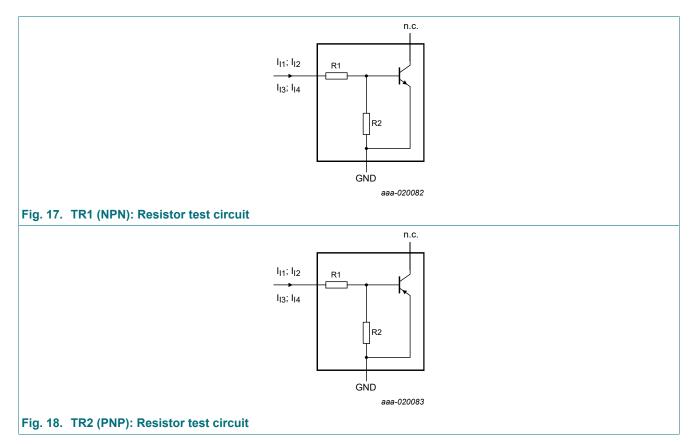
Resistor calculation

Calculation of bias resistor 1 (R1)

$$Rl = \frac{V(I_{12}) - V(I_{11})}{I_{12} - I_{11}}$$

• Calculation of bias resistor ratio (R2/R1)

$$\frac{R2}{R1} = \frac{V(I14) - V(I13)}{R1 \cdot (I14 - I13)} - 1$$

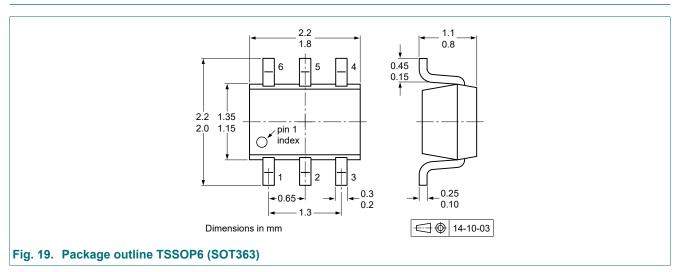

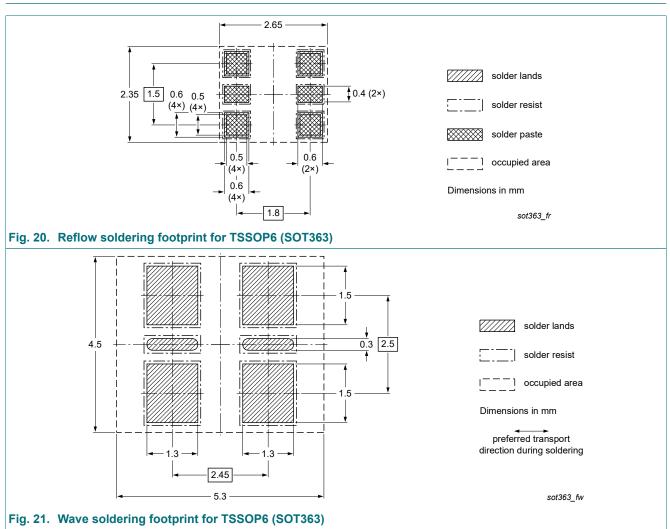
