



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

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Fig. 1 - Forward Current Derating Curve Per Diode






Fig. 2 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current Per Diode




Fig. 5 - Typical Junction Capacitance Per Diode





Fig. 3 - Typical Forward Voltage Characteristics Per Diode
